This experiential course offers students individualized opportunities for observation and participation in management in colleges and universities with partner academic institutions in South Korea, Vietnam, Indonesia, and the Middle East. Students spend a total of 150 hours working in a structured, supervised setting learning about a particular aspect of higher education administration. Additionally, the students prepare academic outputs related to their work in the internship setting that will lead to their dissertation paper.
